2. Open to members enrolled in Cloverbuds, and those students in grades K-2 (ages 5-6) who participate in similar projects.
3. Judging will be done with Danish placing.
4. All work should be done by the member but may be assisted by parent or leader.
5. Poster size is to be 14" by 22".
6. Only one entry per lot/one of each type can be submitted.
7. Premiums will be awarded at \$1.50 per exhibit
